# DRACUT FIRE DEPARTMENT UNIFORM SPECIFICATIONS

# Class A Uniform

- ▲ **Firefighter**: Shall consist of approved navy blue, poly-wool serge material blousecoat, single breasted, four silver buttons, with a Department Patch on the left shoulder, and matching pants.
- ▲ **Lieutenant:** Shall consist of approved navy blue, poly-wool serge material blousecoat, single breasted, four silver buttons, with a Department Patch on the left shoulder, and matching pants. One silver metallic stripe on each cuff sleeve.
- ▲ Captain: Shall consist of approved navy blue, poly-wool serge material blousecoat, single breasted, four silver buttons, with a Department Patch on the left shoulder, and matching pants. Two silver metallic stripes on each cuff sleeve.
- ▲ **Deputy Chief:** Shall consist of approved navy blue, poly-wool serge material blousecoat, double breasted, five gold buttons, with a Department Patch on the left shoulder, and matching pants. Deputy Chief's shall have 3 gold metallic stripes on each cuff sleeves.
- ▲ Chief: Shall consist of approved navy blue, poly-wool serge material blousecoat, double breasted, five gold buttons, with a Department Patch on the left shoulder, and matching pants. The Chief shall have 5 gold metallic stripes on each cuff sleeves.
- ▲ The white dress shirt for all shall be the Flying Cross Brand, with a black tie and black laced dress shoes, with a short visor Bell Cap navy blue for firefighters and white for officers. Department Patch on the left shoulder.
- A Black uniform shoes or boots (not sneakers or walking shoes), navy blue or black socks and black belt shall be worn by all.
- A Rank insignia or Firefighter scramble shall be worn on the collar of the blousecoat. See annex 1 (TBP).
- ▲ Lieutenants, Captains, and Chief Officers shall wear rank insignia's on their white shirt collar.
  - Rank insignia:
    - Lieutenant 1 Silver Vertical Bugle
    - Captain 2 Silver Vertical Bugles
    - Deputy 3 Gold Scramble Bugles
    - Chief 5 Scramble Bugles
- The service stripes are awarded for each 5 year period of honorable service. Service Stripes are worn centered on the outside bottom half of the left sleeve.
  - The service strip is placed 4 inches from the bottom of the sleeve for firefighters. Firefighter's stripes, Color red, will be affixed in the ladder pattern. Officer's stripes, silver for company grade, gold for chief grade, will be affixed in picket fence 1/16 of an inch space from the top metallic stripes for Officers.

## ▲ Firefighters:

- Navy Blue work pants 4 pocket style. EMS BDU are <u>not</u> authorized.
- Flying Cross Light blue shirt: Model #65R5425SS and 15W5425LS.

### ▲ Lieutenant and Captain:

- Navy Blue work pants 4 pocket style. EMS BDU are <u>not</u> authorized.
- Flying Cross Light blue shirt: Model #65R5425SS and 15W5425LS.

#### ▲ Deputy Chiefs:

- Navy Blue Horrace Small, Elbeco or Flying Cross dress pants.
- Flying Cross white shirt Model # 65R5400SS and 15W5400LS
- A Black uniform shoes or boots (not sneakers or walking shoes), navy blue or black socks and black belt shall be worn by all.
- A The Department patch shall be worn on the left shoulder of all Class B uniform shirts and work coats with the option for "Dracut Professional Firefighter EMT" patch only on the right arm.
- A Bell Caps shall be available during the work shift. Rank Insignia shall be worn vertically on cap and helmet shields.

## **Golf Shirts**

- A Golf shirts will be embroidered using the template for the current Red Shirt Friday design with rank and name minus the shoulder embroidery.
- △ Members may choose the Vertex or the 5.11 Professional Polo.
  - Vertex Dark Navy Short Sleeve: Vetex 4000 NVP or 5.11 Professional Polo Navy #41060
    - Firefighters and Company Grade Officers.
  - Vertex White: Vetex 4000 WHP or 5.11 Professional Polo White
    - Chief Officers
  - Vertex Red: Vetex 4000RDP or Professional Polo Red
    - All members red shirt Fridays.
    - Navy Blue work pants: EMS style is authorized for use with Golf Shirt. Must be similar
      in style to Lions #74200, 47400 and 48600 or Fecheimer Urban Defender Model #44800.
      Military BDU are not authorized.

  - Navy Blue with white silkscreen Maltese cross DRACUT FIRE left chest and DRACUT FIRE RESCUE (red) on back
